How a Retiree Can Stay Active as a Volunteer By Andre de Muinck

There are many opportunities for a retiree to stay active, other than travel, golf, bowling leagues and playing cards, etc. I do travel, play some golf, and a lot of league tennis, but the most rewarding activity is donating time to worthwhile organizations.

My name is Andre de Muinck, and I "retired" from JM in 1986. I say "retired" but I was really downsized due to the company's restructuring due to the asbestos litigations. I was with the company for 22 years.

After really retiring from the working world, I needed more work like activities than my grandchildren provided. 15 years ago I became a board member of the homeowner's association of the community where I live with my wife, and I am still active in it.

For about a year, I was a volunteer driver for Senior Resource Center. They provide cars to take the elderly to doctor appointments and other destinations. It was a rewarding activity and a great way to learn the geography of the Denver metropolitan area.

Then in January 2016, I became a volunteer coach at *The Masters Apprentice in Denver*. (<u>www.TheMastersApprentice.org</u>). This organization teaches young men and women, ages 18 to 29, the basic skills they need to enter the construction industry. They are taught Construction Math, Financial Literacy, The "A-Game" of Work Ethic, Career Path Preparation, and Basic Woodworking & Workshop skills. I teach wood shop twice per week.

The students are also taken to other sites to learn basic welding, pipefitting, plumbing, electrical, masonry, and HVAC. Near the end of the 7-week course they select one of those trades. We provide mock interviews and guiding in preparing a resume to train them to approach the construction firms they desire for their selected trade. Our graduates are now much sought after and many get several job offers.

It is a thrill to see each class at their graduation ceremony. You can really sense their excitement for a future with jobs where they can eventually obtain their journeymen's license and a well-paying career. *The Master's Apprentice* will soon double the number of classes and is looking for other volunteers to teach the subjects. Each class is made up of 10 to 14 students at the start. Some inevitably drop out, but we generally end up graduating about 80%.
